

CHOLULA AND ATLIXCO – Unlimited Experiences

Pyramids, churches, and flowers in one day

This experience combines two of the most iconic destinations in Puebla. We begin in Cholula, home to the largest pyramid in the world by volume and a symbol of cultural syncretism, and continue to Atlixco, a Magical Town full of color, flower growing tradition, and local flavors.

Cholula and Atlixco Highlights

- Visit to the Archaeological zone in Cholula
- Tour of the site museum and the Patio de los Altares
- Ascent to the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies
- Panoramic views of the Puebla Valley and the volcanoes
- Transfer to Atlixco, a Magical Town at the foot of Popocatepetl
- Walking tour of Atlixco's Historic Center
- Zócalo, Parish of Santa María de la Natividad, and City Hall
- Explanation of the City Hall murals
- Tasting at "La Pasadita": artisanal bread, chocolate, and local beverages
- Artisanal ice cream tasting at Ximitl
- Visit to the Former Franciscan Convent

Description

We begin the day with a transfer to Cholula to visit its emblematic archaeological site, home to the Great Pyramid, the largest in the world by volume. We will explore the site museum, the Patio de los Altares, and ascend to the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies, offering privileged views of the Puebla Valley and, on clear days, the surrounding volcanoes. Later, we transfer to Atlixco, a Magical Town known for its pleasant climate, flowers, and relaxed atmosphere. We walk through its Historic Center, visiting the Zócalo, the Parish of Santa María de la Natividad, and the City Hall, where murals narrate the history and traditions of the region. The experience is complemented with a tasting at "La Pasadita," we continue with a visit to the Former Franciscan Convent and with a stop at Ximitl to enjoy artisanal ice creams. Finally, we visit the region's nurseries and transfer to Atlimeyaya to explore a trout farm, closing the day with a complete cultural and nature experience.
