

## CUETZALAN AND YOHUALICHAN – Unlimited Experiences

**Duration:** 12–13 hours

**Difficulty:** Easy

**Modality:** Cultural and nature tour with transportation

### **Mist, jungle, and ancestral roots in the Sierra Norte**

Cuetzalan is one of Mexico's most authentic *Pueblos Mágicos*, nestled in the Sierra Norte of Puebla among mountains, coffee plantations, and living indigenous traditions. This experience combines nature, archaeology, and community life to discover a deeper Mexico—one that is felt, walked, and remembered.

### **Highlights of the Cuetzalan & Yohualichan Tour**

- Visit to La Olla Waterfall, surrounded by lush vegetation and natural landscapes
- Tour of the Yohualichan Archaeological Site, an ancient Totonac city
- Cultural connection between Yohualichan and El Tajín
- Tasting and explanation of high-altitude coffee and yolixpa
- Walking tour through Cuetzalan's Historic Center
- Parish of San Francisco de Asís
- Zócalo and Cuetzalan's kiosk
- Visit to the "Iglesia de los Jarritos" (Church of the Little Jars)
- Living indigenous culture and traditional mountain architecture
- Ideal for cultural travelers, nature lovers, and seekers of authentic experiences

### **Itinerary**

- Pick up at your hotel in Puebla
- Transfer to Apulco
- Visit to La Olla Waterfall
- Time for breakfast at the hacienda (optional, not included)
- Transfer to the Yohualichan Archaeological Site
- Guided tour of Yohualichan
- Transfer to Cuetzalan
- Stop at Balcón de Asís for a tasting and explanation of coffee and yolixpa
- Visit to Cuetzalan's Historic Center
- Parish of San Francisco de Asís
- Zócalo
- Kiosk
- Visit to the "Iglesia de los Jarritos" (Church of the Little Jars)
- Free time for shopping or lunch (not included)
- Transfer back to Puebla
- Drop off at your hotel

## Description

The day begins early with a transfer to the Sierra Norte of Puebla, a region known for its lush vegetation and humid climate. The first stop is La Olla Waterfall, a natural setting ideal for connecting with the environment and enjoying a landscape surrounded by jungle. We then continue to the Yohualichan Archaeological Site, one of the most important Totonac settlements in the region, where you will learn about its history, architecture, and its cultural connection with El Tajín. Afterward, we arrive in Cuetzalan, where we stop at Balcón de Asís to taste high-altitude coffee and yolixpa, a traditional beverage known as the “medicine for the soul.” We walk through the Historic Center, visiting the Parish of San Francisco de Asís, the Zócalo, and the Kiosk—spaces that reflect the town’s vibrant community life. We conclude with a visit to the “Iglesia de los Jarritos,” one of Cuetzalan’s most iconic landmarks, before returning to Puebla.
