

- The first stop will be the arrival at Apulco, where you will visit the waterfall (cascada de la Olla) and where you can have breakfast inside the antique farmhouse.
- Yohualichan archaeological zone (1 hour transportation to this place) 1 and a half to 2 hour visit in the archaeological zone of Yohualichan, whose name means "The night's house" and it's the first totonaco settlement.
- 30 minute transportation to Cuetzalan
- 2 hour visit of the historical center
- Zócalo
- Kiosk
- Coffee and Yolixpa (medicine for the heart or soul) tasting and explanation. (Traditional herbal and aguardiente beverage).
- Visit to Iglesia de los Jarritos (church)
- End of the tour and transportation to your Hotel
