



PLACES TO VISIT

National Park Izta - Popo



1.-The experiences Stars • The pick-up will be at the hotel or provided address. Transfer to the National Park, in approximately 2 hours journey, with about 1 and a half hours on unpaved roads.

ITINERARY

2.- Connection with the volcano communities

• We make a stop in San Andrés Calpan, where we will buy fruits and seeds harvested with volcanic ash from different local producers. These items will be consumed during the hike



4.- Access to Izta-Popo National Park (Paso de Cortés)

• Altitude: 3500 meters. At this point, registration takes place in the national park. The guide will provide more information about the national park, its flora and fauna, and the famous legend of the volcanoes and our majestic Iztaccihuatl. This spot marks the beginning of acclimatization for our hike and offers an incredible view of the volcanoes.

5.- Transfer to La Joyita

• Altitude: 3900 meters. We proceed 7 more kilometers along the route until reaching 'La Joyita,' the last parking area to start the hike along the Portillos route

ITINERARIO

3.- Corn as the centerpiece of local cuisine

• Corn is one of the most important foods for the volcano communities, harvested with volcanic ash. From corn, various dishes are prepared. We will stop to taste delicious tamales and atole prepared by a traditional cook.



6. Start of the Hike on Iztaccíhuat • Altitude: 3900 meters The adventure begins! We commence our hike at 3900 meters. The guide will provide you with a certified helmet and walking sticks to ensure your safety during the journey. Waivers will be filled out, along with our environmental and sustainability policies. Depending on the weather and your physical condition, we will progress through the different 'portillos,' reaching a maximum of the 3rd portillo (4524 meters above sea level). Throughout the trek, you will learn about the region's flora and fauna, as well as the historical and ancestral significance of the volcanoes. 7.- First gate: • Altitude: 4125 meters

At this point, we will have some snacks, enjoy the volcano's view, and your guide will check your oxygen using our oximeter to ensure levels proper acclimatization to the altitude. This will be a brief stop to continue our journey.

8.- Second gate: • Altitude: 4350 meters This is the second spot for a brief rest, allowing you to observe one of Iztaccíhuatl's craters, along with the view of the grasslands and Popocatépetl. Your guide will check your oxygen levels again to ensure you can continue with the route.

9.- Third gate: • Altitude: 4500 meters This marks the highest point of our hike. Here, you will have a direct view of Iztaccíhuatl. While you rest and enjoy the view, your guide will prepare a hot coffee for you. We will also have a meal using the items acquired earlier, setting up a small picnic with everything we have to share and savor this incredible experience before descending

• Altitude: 3900 meters After an incredible experience, we will pack up all the equipment. You can enjoy a delicious beer to celebrate your triumph on the mountain before beginning the descent.

11.- Meal at "El Abuelo" Cabin" • Altitude: 3000 meters Following an amazing hike, we will replenish our energy with delicious quesadillas and traditional coffee at 'El Abuelo' cabin. With the assistance of a traditional cook, you can prepare your own blue corn tortilla and add your favorite ingredients.

12.- Return to the City We exit the national park and head back to the city of Puebla.

13.- End of the Experience After this incredible adventure, we will drop you off at the hotel or provided address.

10.- Return to La Joya

INFORMACIÓN ADICIONAL

Includes: Round-trip transportation in a 4x4 vehicle with traveler's insurance, amenities in the vehicle, mountain guide certified by CONANP, certified helmet and trekking poles, oximeter, first aid kit, access to the national park, communication radios, a gift at the end of the tour, health and hygiene protocol, insurance coverage up to \$150,000 MXN for adventure tourism activities.

Included Meals: Breakfast (one tamale and a hot drink), lunch (one quesadilla and a hot drink), snacks (blueberries, peanuts, and candies), fruits, hydration (bottled water, soft drinks, mineral water, juice, and one beer)

Does not include: Access fees, meals, and beverages not mentioned in the itinerary. *The market day (día de plaza) only applies on Thursdays*
