## Description

The tour begins with a transfer to Atlixco, a Pueblo Mágico known for its privileged climate and strong floriculture tradition. We will visit the region's plant nurseries, where you will discover the wide variety of flowers, plants, and fruit trees that characterize the valley. We then continue with a walking tour through the Historic Center of Atlixco, exploring its main square (zócalo), the Parish of Santa María de la Natividad, and the Municipal Palace, where the murals tell the story and identity of the town. The experience is complemented with a tasting at "La Pasadita." Later, we visit the Former Franciscan Convent and make a stop at the Ximitl ice cream shop to try artisan ice creams with unique flavors. Afterward, we transfer to Atlimeyaya, a community surrounded by nature, where you will visit a trout farm, learn about the breeding process, and have the opportunity to feed the fish. A tour that combines culture, landscapes, and local flavors in a single day.
