CACAXTLA AND CHOLULA – Unlimited Experiences

This tour connects two of the most important archaeological sites in central Mexico. From the impressive murals of Cacaxtla to the pyramid with the largest base in Mesoamerica in Cholula, you will experience a journey where the pre-Hispanic past comes to life among ruins, temples, and unique artistic expressions.

Cacaxtla and Cholula Highlights


- Cacaxtla Archaeological Site and its unique pre-Hispanic murals in Mexico
- Guided visit to understand the symbolism and history of the murals
- Cholula Archaeological Site
- Pyramid with the largest base in Mesoamerica
- Site museum and Patio de los Altares
- Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies
- Santa María Tonantzintla Church, jewel of Indigenous Baroque
- San Francisco Acatepec Church with Talavera façade
- Tasting of traditional eggnog (rompope) and local liqueurs
- Ideal for couples, friends, groups, and cultural travelers

Itinerary

- Pick up at your hotel in Puebla or Cholula
- Transfer to Cacaxtla Archaeological Site (approx. 40 minutes)
- Guided tour of Cacaxtla Archaeological Site
- Transfer to Cholula Archaeological Site (approx. 45 minutes)

Visit to Cholula Archaeological Site

- Site museum, Patio de los Altares, and ascent to the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies
- Transfer to Santa María Tonantzintla Church
- Visit and explanation of the temple
- Tasting of rompope and traditional liqueurs
- Visit to Casa Talavera
- Transfer to San Francisco Acatepec Church
- Visit and explanation of the Baroque façade
- End of the tour
- Transfer back to Puebla
- Drop-off at your hotel

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Description

The experience begins with a transfer to Cacaxtla, an archaeological site recognized for preserving some of the best-preserved pre-Hispanic murals in Mesoamerica, where you will learn about the historical and symbolic context of this ancient civilization. We then continue to Cholula to explore its archaeological site, home to the pyramid with the largest base in the world. We will visit the site museum, the Patio de los Altares, and the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies located at the top. The tour continues to Santa María Tonantzintla, a 16th-century temple known for its exuberant Indigenous Baroque style, followed by a tasting of traditional rompope and local liqueurs at Casa Talavera, and a visit to San Francisco Acatepec Church, famous for its spectacular Talavera tile and red-brick façade.
