- Walk through the Vitromurals
- Visit to the "El Centenario" clock factory
- Walk through the Zócalo of Zacatlán
- Tasting of ciders, wines, and local liqueurs
- Bread tasting at a traditional bakery
- Visit to the Former Franciscan Convent
- Free time for lunch (optional)
- End of the tour
- Return transfer and drop-off at your hotel

Description

We begin the day with a transfer to Zacatlán de las Manzanas, a Magical Town surrounded by mist, tradition, and mountain landscapes. Our first stop is the Valley of Piedras Encimadas, a unique natural site where massive rock formations seem to defy gravity, creating imaginative shapes that make this place truly unforgettable. We continue to downtown Zacatlán to visit the Glass Viewpoint overlooking Barranca de los Jilgueros, the colorful Vitromurals, and the iconic "El Centenario" Clock Factory, a local pride and a reference in monumental clockmaking in Latin America.

The experience is complemented with a tasting of apple-based ciders, wines, and traditional liqueurs, along with freshly baked bread. We finish with a visit to the Former Franciscan Convent, one of the oldest buildings in the municipality, closing a day full of nature, history, and flavor.
