This tour is a celebration of Puebla's gastronomy, one of the richest and most renowned in Mexico. Throughout the Historic Center, we combine history, architecture, and traditional snacks so you can discover Puebla through its most iconic flavors.

Highlights of the Gastronomic City Tour

- Cultural walking tour through Puebla's Historic Center
- Tasting of traditional Puebla street food and local specialties
- Traditional Puebla-style molote served with bottled soda
- Taco árabe served with beer or water
- Santa Clara cookie tasting on the traditional Sweets Street
 - Puebla-style churro with a hot beverage, or a traditional *cremita* from La California, or Pasita liqueur
- Ideal for foodies, cultural travelers, and lovers of Mexican cuisine

- Start of the tour in Puebla's Historic Center
- Puebla Cathedral
- Tasting of a traditional molote with soda
- Palafoxiana Library
- Zócalo and explanation of the historic scale model
- Tasting of taco árabe with beer or water
- Chapel of the Rosary
- Sweets Street and tasting of a traditional Santa Clara cookie
- Artist Quarter
- El Parián Handicrafts Market
- Frog Alley
- Tasting of a Puebla-style churro with a hot beverage, or *cremita* from La California, or Pasita liqueur
- End of the tour

Description

We begin this experience in the heart of Puebla's Historic Center, where history blends with aromas and flavors passed down from generation to generation. We visit the Cathedral and the Palafoxiana Library before enjoying a selection of traditional tastings, including molotes, Santa Clara cookies, and the iconic taco árabe.

We continue through the Zócalo and the Chapel of the Rosary, one of the finest examples of Puebla's Baroque architecture, before heading to Sweets Street, where we taste traditional convent-inspired recipes that form an essential part of the city's culinary heritage.

The tour continues through the Artist Quarter, El Parián, and Frog Alley, combining art, tradition, and local life, before ending with a classic Puebla-style churro accompanied by a hot beverage. An experience designed to eat, walk, learn, and enjoy Puebla at a relaxed pace.
