This experience takes you to Atlixco, a Pueblo Mágico known for its privileged climate, vibrant colors, and strong floriculture tradition, combined with a sensory journey that connects you with one of Mexico's most iconic spirits: mezcal. Culture, history, and local flavors all in a single day.

Highlights of the Atlixco & Mezcal Tour

- Visit to Atlixco, a *Pueblo Mágico* and the capital of flowers
- Tour of local nurseries and large commercial greenhouses
- Walking tour through Atlixco's Historic Center
- Visit to the Zócalo, the Parish of Santa María de la Natividad, and the Municipal Palace
- Explanation of the murals inside the Municipal Palace
- Tasting at "La Pasadita": artisanal bread, chocolate, and local beverages
- Artisanal ice cream tasting at Ximitl ice cream shop
- Visit to the former Franciscan Convent
- Guided tour of a traditional mezcal palenque (distillery)
- Tasting of Puebla-produced mezcals

- Return to Puebla
- Drop off at your hotel

Description

We begin the day with a transfer to Atlixco, a *Pueblo Mágico* famous for its pleasant climate, vibrant flowers, and relaxed atmosphere. We visit the nurseries that give identity to the region and walk through its Historic Center, where you will discover the Zócalo, the Parish of Santa María de la Natividad, and the Municipal Palace, home to murals that tell the story and traditions of Atlixco. We continue with a tasting at "La Pasadita," where we will sample artisanal bread, chocolate, and local beverages, followed by a stop at Ximitl ice cream shop to enjoy handcrafted ice creams with unique flavors. We then visit the former Franciscan Convent, one of the most important historic buildings in the city. The experience concludes with a visit to a traditional mezcal palenque, where you will learn about the artisanal production process and enjoy a tasting of mezcal from Puebla. A journey designed to awaken all the senses.
