This experience invites you to explore one of the region's most visually striking and photogenic events, combining art, tradition, and unique landscapes.

Highlights of Monumental Catrinas: Art That Captivates

- Visit to the Valley of the Catrinas in Atlixco
- Monumental *catrinas* ranging from 5 to 8 meters in height
- Artistic pieces crafted in traditional *cartonería*
- Tour of Atlixco's Municipal Palace
- Escalera Ancha, one of the town's iconic viewpoints
- Former Convent of San Francisco
- Glass Viewpoint with panoramic views
- Marigold (*cempasúchil*) fields
- Ideal for couples, friends, groups, and cultural travelers

Itinerary

- Pick up at your hotel or provided address
- Transfer to Atlixco
- Visit to Atlixco's Municipal Palace
- Observation of the first monumental *catrinas*
- Walk along the Escalera Ancha, decorated with flowers and murals
- Visit to the former Convent of San Francisco
- Tour through its chapels and cloisters
- Transfer to the Glass Viewpoint
- View of the monumental Eagle Warrior *catrina*
- Visit to the marigold (*cempasúchil*) fields located on the outskirts of the town
- Transfer back to Puebla
- Drop off at your hotel

Description

The experience begins in the afternoon with a transfer from Puebla to Atlixco, a *Pueblo Mágico* known for its creativity and tradition. The tour starts at the Municipal Palace, where the first monumental *catrinas* welcome visitors.

We continue along the Escalera Ancha, one of Atlixco's most iconic spots, beautifully decorated with flowers and murals, followed by a visit to the former Convent of San Francisco, a historic site filled with calm and symbolism.

The journey continues to the Glass Viewpoint, where you can admire one of the most impressive monumental *catrinas* in the exhibition, framed by panoramic views of the valley. We conclude with a visit to the marigold (*cempasúchil*) fields.

A visual, cultural, and deeply meaningful experience that captures the essence of Day of the Dead in Puebla.
